Speaker: Pearse Moroney

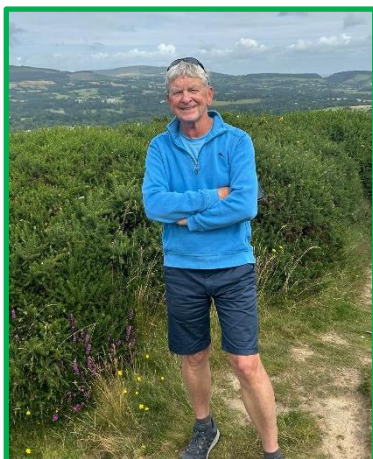
Last year at this time, Pearse gave us a great presentation on Irish saints and scholars focussing on St. Patrick as St Patrick’s Day occurs in March.
